the TRUSTEES (which term, shall unless repugnant to the subject
or context be deemed to mean and include the Trustees for the
time being under the Indenture of Trust dated the Twenty-third

day of February one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine hereit -after recited) of the OTHER PART WHEREAS by an Indenture -

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under its control shall be managed by a person to be nominated by the Trustees who may or may not be a Trustee himself to be called the Honorary Superintendent who shall be assisted by an Advisory Committee consisting of such representatives elected or nominated by the Trustees under such rules as may from time to time be framed by or under the directions of the said Trustees and such powers may be given to the Honorary Superintendent of vetoing any decision of any Advisory Committee and/or all such other powers as the Trustees may think proper AND WHEREAS the said Indenture further provides that the Trustees shall be entitled to -frame alter add to and to amend the rules and regulations governing the Trust from time to time as occasion may arise AND WHEREAS the said Indenture further provides that in case the Trustees should differ in opinion in any matter the -opinion of the majority should prevail and the said Indenture further provides that the said Donors and all persons having lawfully or equitably claiming any estate or any interest in the said Trust premises or Trust estate or any of them or any part thereof from under or in trust for them the said Donors shall and will from time to time and at all times at the -request and costs of the said Donors their heirs and assigns do and execute or cause to be done and executed all such acts deeds and things whatsoever for further and more perfectly assuring the said Trust premises and every part thereof unto and to the use of the said Trustees their heirs successors and assigns in the manner aforesaid as shall or may be reason--ably required AND WHEREAS pursuant to the powers provided for in the said Indenture dated the Twenty third day of February one thousand nine hundred and twenty nine the said Sreekissen Jaju resigned from his position as Trustee and Pandit Hriday

dated the Twenty-third day of February One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine and made between the Donors Founders of the One Part and the Trustees (other than the Trustee Pandit Hriday Nath Kunzru) and Srikissen Jaju of the Other Part after reciting that the Donors Founders were seised and possessed of and otherwise entitled to as absolute owners of the lands hereditaments and premises mentioned and fully described in the Schedule "A" to the said Indenture and also reciting that the Donors Founders were also possessed of and absolute--ly entitled to the shares Debentures etc. specified in Schedule "B" to the Indenture and also reciting that the Donors Founders being desirous of providing facilities for giving education to the people ordinarily residing in Pillani and other places in Rajputana generally and being desirous of providing for the erection maintenance and upker of the buildings and houses for the school, college, board, houses and quarters of the school and college etc., had prior to the execution of the said Indenture dated the Twenty-third day of February One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, transferred assigned and handed over to the said Trustees (other than the said Pandit Hriday Nath Kunzru) and the said Srikissen Jaju the buildings and premises therein mentioned and had dedicated a sum of Rs 692783/0/9 (Rupees Six Lacs ninety-two thousand seven hundred and eighty three and pies nine) in the shape of shares and other investments fully described and mentioned in the -Schedule "B" thereunder upon the trusts and with and subject to the powers conditions and provisions therein expressed AND WHEREAS paior to the execution of the said Indenture of Trust dated the Twenty-third day of February One thousand nine hundred and twenty nine the said -Trust was and thereafter has been known as "THE BIRLA EDUCATION TRUST AND WHEREAS the said Indenture provides that subject to the control of the Trustees and to such rules and regulations as have been andmay. from time to time be passed by the Trustees the affairs of the Trust shall be conducted and its objects carried out and the institutions

under -

WHEREAS since the execution of the said Indenture dated the Twenty third day of February one thousand nine hundred and twenty nine the Trustees from time to time acquired proper—ties upon the trusts mentioned in the said Indenture dated Twenty—third day of February one thousand nine hundred and twenty nine AND WHEREAS the said Trustees ordinarily reside at different places which are at a great distance from each other AND WHEREAS in the premises the Trustees have for the purpose of proper management of the trust funds and for the guidance of the Trustees fremed the Eyles hereinafter mention—ed AND WHEREAS in order that there may be no question regard—ing the propriety or validity of the said Rules the Donors Founders have at the request of the Trustees agreed to join in these presents NOW THIS MEMORANDUM WITNESSETH as follows:—

1.- The Trust has all along been, and shall hereafter be known as "THE BIRLA EDUCATION TRUST".

- 2.- The Trustees are and shall be at liberty to accept and acquire properties for the purpose of the Trusts mentioned in the said Indenture dated the Twenty-third day of February one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine and are and shall be at liberty to amalgamate the same with the original Trust Estate or keep the same or any portion thereof separate from the rest, with further liberty to the Trustees that any acceptance or acquisition of properties may be either for the general purposes of the said Trust or earmarked for special or particular purposes not inconsistent with the objects set forth in the said Indenture.
- 3.- One of the Trustees representing the Birla family shall be elected by the Trustees as the President of the Board of Trustees of the Birla Education Trust and he shall preside at all meetings of the Trustees. He shall continue to hold office till he resigns

when another Trustee of the said family may be elected in his place. He may nominate any other Trustee member of the Birla family or any other Trustee to act on his behalf during his absence from the country.

- the President for the time being may from time to time think fit and transact such business as may be necessary for carrying on the administration of the Trust including the framing, amending and altering of the Rules and Regulations for the time being of the Trust. A meeting of the Trustees shall be convened by the President on a written requisition, expressly stating the objects of the meeting, of two or more Trustees—and if no meeting be called by the President inspite of such requisition within a month of the date of requisition, requisitionists will themselves be entitled to call such a meeting—No other business except as mentioned in the requisition.
  - The President may instead of convening a meeting circulate or cause to be circulated resolution or resolutions for the opinion of the Trustees. The Trustees may pass resolution or resolutions by circulating without actually holding a meeting.
  - 6 .- Two Trustees shall form a Quorum.
  - 7.- Questions arising at any meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes and in case of an equality of votes the President shall have a second and casting wote.
  - 8.- The President shall ordinarily preside at the meeting.

    If at any time the President is not present within fifteen minutes of the time appointed for the purpose of holding the meeting Trustees present shall choose one of themselves to be
    the Chairman of such meeting.

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A meeting of the Trustees for the time being at which a quorum is present shall become competent to exercise all or any of the authorities powers and discretions by or under this Deed vested in them or otherwise exercisable by them.

10.- One Trustee will not be liable for the acts and - defaults of the other Trustee or Trustees.

Trustees and passed by a majority shall be as valid and as effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of the Trustees duly called and convened.

12.- The Trustees may open an account or accounts in the name of the "Birla Education Trust" or in the name of any one or more of the Trustees with any Bank or Banks and - operate on any such account. Any such account may be operated upon by such person or persons (whether a Trustee or not) as the Trustees may authorize in that behalf. In the event of any such person or persons not being available to operate - on the account, the same may be operated upon and cheques may be signed and endorsed and all acts necessary in connection with any account or accounts of the Trusts - may be done by any one or more of the Trustees or their constituted attorneys if so authorized by the said person or persons or by the Trustees.

other documents or properties for the time being forming Fund
part of the said Trust may be kept in deposit in any Bank
or Banks as the Trustees consider proper and any property
so deposited may be withdrawn on the receipt of any two of
the Trustees for the time being or their constituted attorneys
authorized in that behalf. The Trustees by their resolutionpassed in the manner hereinbefore provided may authorize the
Bank or Banks concerned to collect dividends and interests
and profits rents and other dues and grant valid receipts

in discharge therefor.

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14.- All agreements, contracts, instruments, documents and papers to be signed or executed on behalf of the - Trust may be signed by any two of the Trustees and shall be as effective and binding as if it was signed by all the Trustees.

15.- The Trustees may delegate any of their powers to a Committee consisting of such person or persons whether members of their body or not as they think fit. Any Trustee may delegate any of his powers by a Power of - Attorney or other writing to his nominee or nominees - who will be entitled to exercise the powers delegated in the same manner as the Trustees or the Trustee could do in person.

16.- It is expressly made clear that the power of the Trustees to frame, add to, alter or abrogate the rules for the time being including the foregoing rules is not in any way prejudiced.

17.- In case it be construed that any of the foregoing provisions cannot validly be made a part of the rules and regulations contemplated by the said Deed of Inden-ture dated the Twenty-third day of February one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine the same may still be - exercised by the Trustees as fresh powers granted by the Donors to and upon the Trustees as being necessary for carrying on the administration of the Trust.

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## THE SCHEDULE "A" ABOVE REFERRED TO :

- 1. ALL THOSE two buildings and premises used as school buildings with lands on which they stand being partly two storied and partly three storied with the compounds walls wells etcetra and which are bounded on the North by a road, on the South by Nora, on the East by Vidyapith road and On the West by Nora at Pilani within the -- Territories of the Maharaja of Jaipur in Rajputana.
- 2. ALL THOSE two storied masonry buildings used as Boarding House with the compounds and compound walls etcetra together with the lands on which they stand bounded on the North by Nora, on the -- South by a road, on the East by a road and on the West by a well and situate at Pilani within the Territories of the Maharaja of Jaipur in Rajputana.
- 3. ALL THOSE building and lands measuring 333 feet east to west and 224 feet north to south intended and set apart for College Building and which is bounded on the North by new road, on the South by Kucha tank, on the East by lands belonging to Khanan and Matilal and on the West by the road leading to Nara and situate at Pilani within the Territories of the Maharaja of Jaipur in -- Rajputana.
- 4. ALL THOSE three Bungalows with the lands thereunder and compounds wells etcetra now used as quarters for teachers and which is bounded on the North by Nora, on the South by the Boarding House and on the East by Vidyapith Road and on the West by the Boarding House and situate at Pilani within the Territories of the Maharaja of Jaipur in Rajputana.
- 5. ALL THOSE two Bungalows used as quarters with the lands there under bounded on the North by a Road, on the South by Malis House on the East by a Road and on the West by vacant lands and situate at Pilani within the Territories of the Maharaja of Jaipur in -- Rajputana.

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6. ALL THOSE five Bungalows used as quarters which are bounded on the North by a Road, on the South by Raj lands on the East by a Road and on the West by a Road and situate at Pilani within the Territories of the Majaraja of Jaipur in Rajputana.

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
